For those without a physical Lent Box

Early Childhood (Age 2-Kindergarten) – all instructions, challenge cards, and activity pages available to print from website

- Instructions and challenge card
- Week 1: washi tape (or masking tape)
- Week 2: Kool-Aid packet, paint brush, “Fragrant Thanks” activity sheet, water, bowl, apron or smock, paper towels to protect your workspace. (This craft makes a “paint” from the Kool-Aid. Feel free to use regular paint if desired)
- Week 3: “Game Cards” activity page, scissors, flashlight
- Week 4: “Love Like Jesus Chart” activity page, crayons, heart stickers
- Week 5: “Stop” activity page, paper plate, crayons or markers, scissors, masking tape
- Week 6: Hosanna Rock song from Early Childhood Spotify Playlist or search YouTube, a party blower.

Elementary (Grades 1-5) – all instructions, challenge cards, and activity pages available to print from website.

- Instructions and challenge card
- Week 1: Paper, marker, “Kindness Scenarios” activity page, superhero flyer or other toy that can be safely flung across the room
- Week 2: 4 strips of construction paper (any color, size 3 inches x 8 inches), crayons or markers, tape or stapler, “Spot the Difference” activity page
- Week 3: “Patience Grid” and “Patience Scenarios” activity pages, small items to use as tokens (1 per person playing)
- Week 4: “Back in the Jar Instructions” activity page, 5 ounce plastic cup, ping pong ball, markers, scissors, piece of yarn about 12-24 inches long.
- Week 5: “Take Your Pick” activity page, scissors, opaque bag (like a brown paper lunch bag). Oreos (2) or other cookie of similar shape (optional)
- Week 6: Party blowers (2), cotton balls (2), something to make a finish line (yardstick, masking tape, long piece of yarn)

Middle School (Grades 6-8) – all instructions, challenge cards, and activity pages available to print from website.

- Instructions and challenge card
- Week 1: headphones (noise canceling is best), index cards (5 per person), Whisper Challenge instructions (links on website), pen
- Week 2: Mad Lib Prayer activity page (3), “regular” Mad Lib activity page (1), Feelings Wheel, pen
- Week 3: 1 John 4:9-10 Poster, metallic marker (or regular marker), masking tape

- Week 4: Empty Tomb Garden Craft – 2.5 inch terra cotta pot, 6 inch plastic plantar base, small pebbles (1/2 cup), soil (1 cup), wheat grass seeds (1.5 Tbsp)
- Week 5: no supplies needed
- Week 6: “I am” stickers

- Stickers or markers to mark squares

Easter It: Easter Jam!

- Eggs (plastic or real) 1 per person
